Founded by the Rigal family in 1755, the company's history is synonymous with that of prestige wines from Cahors and the Southwest; a regional hallmark of tradition, authenticity and quality.

The Original Sauvignon Blanc is crafted from the sunniest clay & limestone hillsides of Gascony, in the Southwest regions where the original wild grape was discovered so many centuries ago. From *sauvage* origins, Rigal has created an exceptionally elegant wine, with citrus fruit aromas, peach notes, a perfect balance of acidity and a rare freshness. Discover a beautiful expression of Sauvignon Blanc, an enjoyable wine to drink on its own, or with seafoods and poultry.

On the 2010 harvest, winemaker Pierre Pouttenoire commented: "A rainy Spring, followed by a very dry Summer, provided these grapes with ideal conditions for a very healthy maturation. The vines didn't suffer much from the drought, thanks to the hydric reserves accumulated during the Spring. Good alcohol degree and good acidity – this vintage delivered a low yield, but with aromatic and qualitative potential that is higher than last year. 2010 is a great vintage from Gascogne."
