TASTING NOTES

Eye

Beautiful concentration, with rich hues of dark crimson, raspberry red at the edges.

Nose

an impressive nose of strawberry and vanilla, with accents of cinnamon and smoke.

Palate

Thick, rich, concentrated upon entrance, moving into notes of ripe strawberry and blueberry. Long, spicy finish, with hints of dark cherries, espresso and chocolate.
